Genfest 2024

Genfest 2024 was an event of testimonies and entertainment in Aparecida, Brazil with 4,000 young people from 50 countries and a live streaming linking 120 nations from all over the world.

In July 2024, 30 young adults attended from various parts of North America: Texas, Florida, Montreal & Quebec & Saskatoon Canada, California, New Jersey, New York, Illinois, Maryland.

Phase 1 - Volunteering at the Fazenda da Esperanca in Guaranciquetà.

Phase 2 – 2 days of celebration: songs, experiences, mimes, proposals.

Phase 3 - United World Communities.

Gen Unit


Two gen boys returned from Genfest 2024, came together and decided they wanted to have a gen unit group that meets regularly. Others jumped on board and a small group (from Canada & the US) started meeting. They are committed to journeying together to help them grow spiritually and humanly. They engage in discussions and reflections on spirituality and leadership, virtually and in person.

A few months later they brought their friends together locally to tell them about the Focolare spirituality. Now they too meet regularly.



Growth and Leadership

The Infinite Mindset (TIM) is a program of personal growth and leadership that encourages a broader, long-term perspective. It enables us to view life's challenges and opportunities through a more expansive lens, focusing on sustainable goals and enduring objectives rather than short-term achievements. Being open to learning and growth makes a powerful impact on the person themself and those around them.



For example:

One person felt the desire to be **baptized** and was admitted into the process which led to the official baptism in his church.

Others have grown in the belief that God loves them immensely and learned to accept themselves as they are and in turn gained self-esteem. Some felt the courage to simply not give up and increase the good habits in their daily life, finding the strength to focus on taking better care of their physical health and simply fight the good battle another day.

Others decided to better themselves by attending **Focolare youth formation programs** offered in other countries.

Still, some found space for true inner **reflection about their calling from God**, unity and the importance of forgiveness.

Blessed Chiara Luce Badano prayer service

Seven young adults led the Chiara Luce Badano prayer service in October. We returned once again to reflect on Chiara's life, how she lived and the example she left behind. This year we also reflected on the life of the young blessed, Carlo Acutis.

Carlo was born in 1991 into an Italian family in London, England. He was a teenager who loved soccer and video games but had an extraordinary mission: to use the internet to spread faith. By age 15, Carlo had created a global online exhibition cataloging Eucharistic miracles, inspiring countless people worldwide. His deep devotion to the Eucharist shaped his life, attending daily Mass and Eucharistic adoration from age seven. Carlo also organized aid for the homeless at nine, embodying his belief in putting love into action.

Carlo Acutis will be canonized on April 27, 2025 as the first millennial to be proclaimed a saint.

Men's Retreat

YCNA hosted its first Men's Retreat in Mariapolis Luminosa.

The program focused on the Focolare theme "called and sent" and the Synodality Process: a changing church in a changing world.

Participants reflected on the meaning of the theme and concrete ways to put it into practice. Prayer and quiet time gave space for deepening a relationship with God while small groups enabled dialogue and an exchange of ideas.





Social Media

Some Gen have experienced the effects of social media in their lives with anxiety, a sense of wasted time, ...etc. They have also seen the effect it has on people around them and for that reason, they have decided to pause on using social media. As a result, they say they feel better in life, they can better tend to their tasks such as work, studies and building relationships. They feel freer, more at peace.
